Using FSC and recycled products where available is standard practise and we use only vegetable oil based printing inks.

We operate with sympathy to our rural location taking due care to ensure we are not a disruption

to local wildlife or residence in any manner. Our factory was constructed in 1999 following carefully planned guidelines to ensure our impact on the local environment was minimised.

For many years we have supported a local youth football club and assisted where possible with sponsoring award events and assisting them in raising funds for the club.

IPH Print Ltd's Chairman has recently been engaged in visiting local WI events and speaking about the history of printing in Coventry.

IPH Print Ltd's MD has spent time in recent years working voluntarily in South Africa with UNICEF, helping schools and communities in the Transkei region. The companies founder Mark Jennings-Bates and his wife now operate their own charitable foundation, Rally4Life, with the aim of raising £2m to help bring clean water and safe living conditions to children and families in Africa and South America.
